

Sexual Coercion

Comprehensive Learning Guide

These discussion questions will help your group identify and examine key themes and messages in the video Sexual Coercion. After viewing the video, begin talking through the discussion questions in small groups. Break out of small groups and discuss thoughts and opinions as a large group.

Discussion

1. What was your initial reaction to the short film? What kinds of feelings or emotions arose for you?

2. Using your own words, explain the meaning of sexual coercion. Provide an example from the film.

3. What are some ways a person can verbally give consent? Additionally, what are some ways a person can non-verbally give consent?

4. In the film, Lana, Collin, and Sam all try to pressure and/or coerce someone else even though they know the other person is uncomfortable. In each situation, what should they have done differently?



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Independent Activies

Matching Game: Using the worksheet provided, match the word to the matching definition. Each word is only used once.

Crossword Puzzle: This puzzle will test your knowledge of terms and concepts

learned in this video. <u>Note</u>: If an answer has two words, there is no space in the puzzle.

Small Group Activities

Create an Action Plan: In a group of 3 or 4, discuss ways you could seek help if you or someone you know is being sexually coerced, such as a trusted adult. Come up with a total of 5 answers and share with other groups.

Examples of Consent: In a group of 3 or 4, brainstorm examples of verbal consent and nonverbal consent. In addition, create a list of examples of someone who is not giving consent. What would that look or sound like?

<u>Large Group Activity</u>

Socratic Seminar Discussion: Form a circle so that everyone can see each other, including the facilitator(s). The discussion will begin with a focus question based on the relationships seen within the film (Ex.: Sam & Zoe or Lana & Max). Each student should contribute at least once with their own thoughts, opinions, or experiences.


